

JEFFREY GOODMAN

Jeffrey Goodman is a magna cum laude graduate of Harvard in Visual and Environmental Studies. He founded GoodmanCharlton, a design firm specializing in hospitality design, residential design and furniture design in 1998 with Steven Charlton, an honors graduate from Brighton School of Art in England.

In 2008, GoodmanCharlton completed the grand renovation of the historic Empire Hotel near Lincoln Center in New York designing most of the lobby furniture and all of the furniture in the 420 rooms. This hotel was used as a primary location for the 2009-11 seasons of the *Gossip Girl* TV series as well as a location in the movie *Sex and the City 2*.

In 2010, GoodmanCharlton completed the design and development of The Empire Room, an upscale cocktail lounge in the Empire State Building, custom-designing all of the furniture, carpeting and lighting.

Their work has been published worldwide including a cover story in *House Beautiful* and a cover story in the book *Designing for Small Homes*. Their hotel interiors have also been featured in *Interior Design*, *Hospitality Design*, *The New York Times*, *Vogue*, *Time Out*, *Departures* and *Elle Décor* among other publications.

Goodman Charlton also creates and licenses furniture, art, hardware, lighting and rug designs to companies including American Leather, RFA Decor, Nuevo Living, Du Verre Hardware, Della Robbia, Remington Lighting and Designtex which are marketed around the world.

Their furniture has been used in many celebrity homes including those of Madonna, Prince, Nicholas Cage, Laura Dern, Ringo Starr and Bruce Springsteen; music videos by Michael Jackson and Prince; advertising campaigns by Gucci and hotel lobbies including the Hard Rock Hotel Las Vegas and W Los Angeles, among others.
